## **LESSON 1 THE BIBLE: GOD'S INFALLIBLE WORD**

Memory Verse: 2 Timothy 3:16 "All scripture is given by inspiration of God, and is profitable for doctrine, for reproof, for correction, for instruction in righteousness."

1. Characteristics of God's Word.

- a. God and his word are one (John 1:1).
- b. God is alive! Therefore, his word is also alive (Hebrews 4:12).

(1) God's word is powerful, and therefore able to change our lives (Hebrews 4:12).

- c. God's word is truth (John 17:17).
- d. God's word is forever settled (Psalm 119:89).

(1) God's word will not change (Psalm 89:34).

- e. God's word is durable (Isaiah 40:8 and Matthew 24:35).
  - (1) His truth endures to all generations (Psalm 100:5).
- f. All scripture is given by inspiration of God (God breathed) (2 Timothy 3:16).
  - (1) And...is profitable:
  - (2) For doctrine (instruction or teaching).
  - (3) For reproof (conviction).
  - (4) For correction.
  - (5) For instruction (training, discipline) in righteousness.
- g. God's word is spiritually discerned (1 Corinthians 2:14).
  - (1) God's word is not open to individual interpretation (2 Peter 1:20-21).
    - (a) The Holy Spirit gives revelation knowledge and understanding to God's word (John 14:26).
- 2. Let's get down to some practical application.
  - a. Jesus instructed us to live by every word that proceeds from the mouth of God (Matthew 4:4).
  - b. We are also instructed to rightly divide the word of truth (2 Timothy 2:15).
    - (1) Divide the Old Covenant from the New Covenant.
    - (2) The Bible contains words spoken by the devil (Genesis 3:1-5).
    - (3) The Bible contains words spoken by people (Matthew 16:13-17 then, verses 21-23).
    - (4) The Bible contains symbolism (John 10:9).
  - c. Therefore, we cannot pattern our lives after everything that happened in the Bible (1 Corinthians 10:1-11).
- 3. Then, how are we to live by God's word?
  - a. We govern our live by the commandments of God (1 John 5:3).
  - b. We experience abundant life through the promises of God (2 Peter 1:2-4).
  - c. To sum up (John 8:31-32).
