## **Memory Verse:**

**Romans 6:23** "For the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord."

- 1. Foundational scripture (Ephesians 1:7).
- a. Definition: *Redemption* -to ransom or to buy back something that originally belonged to you.
- 2. In the beginning (Genesis 1:27).
  - a. Man was God's creation. Therefore, he was legally God's property.
    - (1) But God created man with a free will (Genesis 2:8-9,16-17).
      - (a) Question: Why were two specific trees necessary in the Garden of Eden?
- 3. Adam and Eve made the choice to disobey God with their free will.
  - a. Eve was deceived (tricked) (Genesis 3:1-6 with 1 Timothy 2:14).
  - b. But Adam was not deceived (1 Timothy 2:14).
- 4. The results of Adam's disobedience (Genesis 2:17).
  - a. Not physical death. Adam lived 930 years (Genesis 5:5).
  - b. But, spiritual death (separation from God)
    - (1) The result of sin is spiritual death (Romans 6:23).

Death reigned from Adam to Moses because of sin. (Romans 5:12-19)

The remedy for sin.

- a. Jesus redeemed us (bought us back) (1 Peter 1:18-19).
- b. We have a responsibility.
  - (1) Recognize that redemption is a free gift (Ephesians 2:8-9).
  - (2) Repentance toward God (Isaiah 53:6 with John 14:6).
  - (3) Receiving Jesus Christ as Savior (John 1:12 with Romans 10:9).
