LESSON 8 THE LOVE OF GOD

Memory Verse: 1 John 4:8 "He that loveth not knoweth not God; for God is love."

- 1. Foundational scriptures (John 3:16 and 1 John 4:11).
 - a. Observation: All of us need a greater revelation of God's love toward us (Ephesians 3:16-19).
 - b. Understanding God's love delivers us from fear (1 John 4:16-18).
 - (1) Even to the extent of having boldness in the day of judgment (verse 17 -above).
- (a) Behold (look and see, be aware of, consider and know) what manner of love the Father has bestowed upon us (1 John 3:1).
- 2. But," ...we ought also to love one another" (1 John 4:11).
 - a. The love of God is shed abroad in our hearts (Romans 5:5).
 - (1) We don't need any more love; The love of God is already within us!
- 3. Manifesting the love of God toward others.
 - a. Whoso keepeth his word (1 John 2:5).
- (1) Definition: *keepeth* -to set a watch, to guard by keeping the eye upon in order to prevent loss or injury.
- 4. Practical Application (1 Peter 3:9 from the New American Standard Bible).
 - a. Examining three modes of manifestation.
 - (1) Receive an insult, return an insult.
 - (2) Receive an insult, return nothing.
 - (3) Receive an insult, return a blessing (Matthew 5:44).
 - b. Giving a blessing ...that you might inherit a blessing (Luke 6:38).
 - (1) Because, love never fails (1 Corinthians 13:8a).
